



HEAR YE, HEAR YE!

Announcing information you should know for the upcoming Blues Express LSR Convention and WHY you should attend.

The time is upon us to start registration for the Blues Express in Baton Rouge, June 26-29, 2025. This is Thursday through Sunday and will be filled with fun and educational activities for both model railroaders and for their families. The convention will be in a region that has a bounty of interesting scenic and historical sites and is in the heart of Cajun food country.

Registration is now open for the convention at the convention website: https://bluesexpress2025.com/. This site is where you'll get registered for the convention, show you the clinics available, book your hotel rooms and explain to you a whole slew of other things available at the convention. Did I mention the Cajun food?

The Early Bird Registration and discounted hotel rate will end on May 15, 2025. You shouldn't wait for that date. Get in early because for some activities there is limited space available.

Over the coming months, I'll be sending out information via emails to you about the clinics and what makes our LSR conventions clinics so special.

Let me start with a Make and Take clinic presented by LSR's own Achievement Program (AP) chairman Duane Richardson, MMR. Duane will be leading this clinic where you will be building a speeder shed. This class has limited seats as the room will only accommodate 18 people. You will need to furnish your own tools (but the list is pretty basic) and purchase the shed components (but they're available in N, HO, S, and O scale and the fee is pretty small). All the details are on the clinic page at https://bluesexpress2025.com/make-take/.

If you don't know who Duane is, let me introduce you to him: Duane is a lifelong modeler with too many accomplishments for me to even list in a short email. He is MMR #391 and along with his father, MMR #345, became the first father-and-son MMRs. Duane is our region's AP Chairman and is always eager to help with a tip or trick to help you "become a better modeler". He has presented clinics locally, regionally and nationally on topics too numerous to mention, but are always detail-oriented and relevant for any modeler, for any scale.

How about a clinic on **weathering a diesel locomotive**? Or **track planning a layout**? These two clinics will be presented by Walt Liles. He has been a member since 2003 of the Piedmont Division of the Southeast Region (SER) of the NMRA. He is currently serving as Director of Operations and is a past Superintendent, Director of Operations, and Director. Walt has served as the Secretary with the SER for 2 terms and was the Chairperson for the SER 2023 Cartersville Express Convention. He is a member of the North Atlanta Rail Barons and the Tri-State Model Railroaders.

First, Walt will be presenting a clinic on weathering a diesel locomotive covering a certain look with diesels. This includes where to look for key details in weathering a diesel locomotive and looking at the effects of weathering with different colors of locomotives. Walt will use many different weathering products and techniques to make that new locomotive look aged and used. This is a fun clinic to learn some techniques about weathering applications.

Secondly, Walt will have a clinic covering layout design that will go over track planning including different aspects of the track, grades, space limitations and fitting specific industries into your layout. He will be discussing different elements of track and why we do certain things on our layouts. Just like the prototype we need certain items on our model layouts just like the railroads.

This is a very informative clinic that will help you plan expansion to your current layout of aid you with your next layout.

These are just two of the presenters and three informative clinics that you can see at the Blues Express. But wait! There's more!!! The Non-Rail schedule will include fun-filled activities that will appeal to both Rails and Non-Rails. Ask your medical questions to a licensed medical professional, or learn the insights of playing poker from a professional poker player that has participated in national poker tournaments. Other activities will include touring iconic Baton Rouge attractions, as well as other fun activities at the convention hotel.

The Blues Express 2025 convention will take place at the Holiday Inn Baton Rouge South. Overnight accommodations and convention meeting rooms are all under one roof, for convenient access. Hotel amenities include an on-site restaurant, lounge, room service, exercise facility, and swimming pool.
